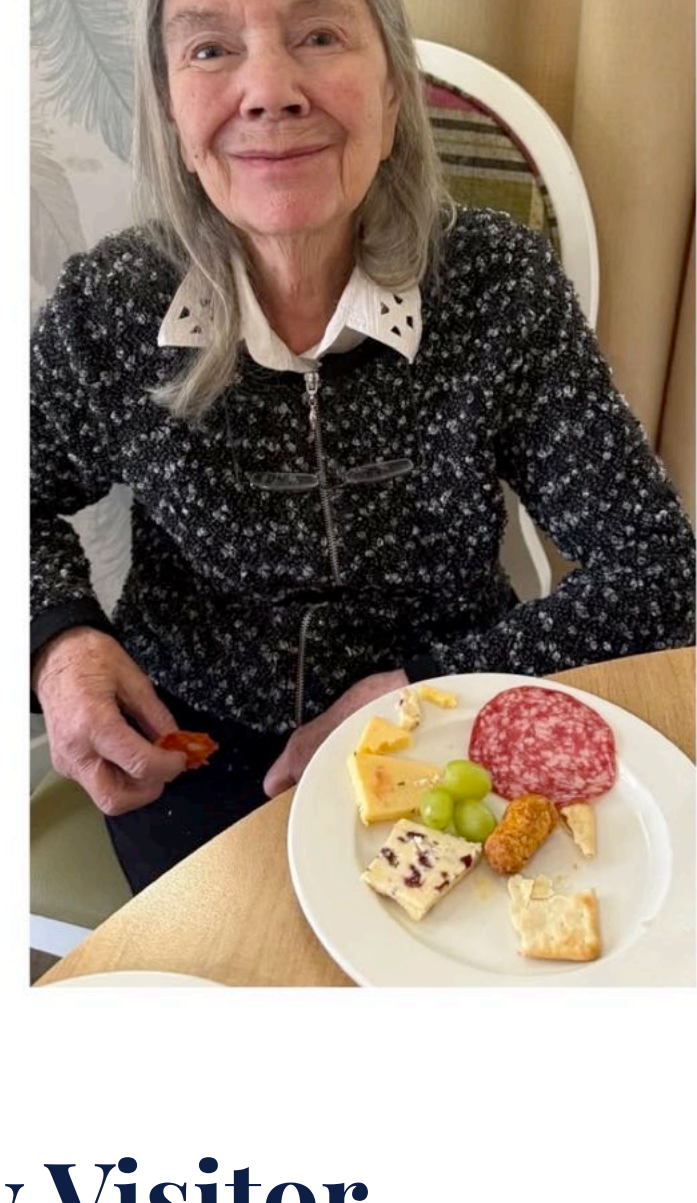
Christmas Comes to Angusfield House
